Specifically, recommendations on the hiring of 2 Part Time and 3 Full time Firefighter/EMT applicants, 1 Part Time/Paid on Call Firefighter promotion to Firefighter Lieutenant, 1 Full Time Firefighter/EMT for conditional appointment to Firefighter and promotion to EMS Coordinator and updates on pending applicants to Firefighter/EMT and ongoing hiring process.
4. The Commission will then reconvene into Open Session for purposes of potential additional discussion and/or action on matters discussed in closed session and adjournment.
