Minutes:

1. The meeting was called to order at 12:07pm. Roll call was taken.
2. Acknowledgement of meeting recording status - This meeting was not recorded.
3. Finalization of minutes from the October 24 meeting - Minutes were finalized and the signed version will be provided to the Town Clerk.
4. Updates on recent activity / requests regarding the cemeteries – D. Darby reported that there have been no new contacts made regarding his Sexton responsibilities since the last meeting.
5. Discussion of Cemetery Rules relating to use of temporary grave markers: J. Kenney explained that he had a conversation with a family member about the grave of a recent burial which now has a temporary grave marker. The family’s plan is to have a permanent marker installed in the Spring.
6. Review of proposed changes to Cemetery Rules and vote to bring updated version to Selectboard. The edits suggested at the October Meeting were reviewed, revised and finalized. J. Kenney to arrange for a review by the Selectboard.
7. Update on activities related to use of the previous and current budget: D. Darby noted that the Highway Department was completing the installation of the new South Cemetery flagpole. J. Kenney noted that the granite posts at the South Thompson Burial Ground will be set in the Spring.
8. Budget request for fiscal 2027: Commissioners agreed that a \$500 budget request to cover small, unexpected expenses would be appropriate. J. Kenney to submit the budget request.
9. Planning for next Cemetery Commission activities or next Cemetery Commission Meetings: The next meeting will be held on Monday, January 19, 2026, at 10:00am
