Chairman Tisler informed the body that the meeting notices have been posted in the three regular posting areas: Town Hall, Recycle Center and Equity Hall.

Motion (Pellman/Nowak) to approve the April 14, 2026 agenda as presented. Motion carried 5/0.

Motion (Zeitler/Patenaude) to approve the March 10, 2026 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 5/0.

Treasurer Rymer presented the March 2026 financial report, with the following account balances:

Clerk Olson presented the April 2026 vouchers, checks #17430 through #17486 and electronic transfers, totaling \$34,021.84. Motion (Zeitler/Nowak) to approve the submitted vouchers. Motion carried 5/0.

Motion (Pellman/Patenaude) to approve building permit #4 to Larry Wilson, and #5 to Barton Kostreva as presented by Zoning Administrator, Tom Rich. Motion carried 5/0.

Public Comment:

Larry Wilson spoke on the condition of W 16th Road and requested repairs be made. He also spoke on the amount of garbage being dumped along the roadway.

Business (Roads):

1. Clerk Olson provided an update on the costs incurred for Blizzard Elsa. A submission has been made to the WI Disaster Fund for reimbursement.
2. Supervisor Pellman and Troy are currently reviewing roads to be crack filled this year.
3. Cedar Corporation is beginning to work on ARIP Applications for 23rd Rd and 8th Rd.

4. Troy will be attending the Road School conference April 27-29 in Wisconsin Dells. Compensation policy for offsite training was reviewed and discussed.

Business Issues:

1. Clerk Olson spoke on the .gov email accounts. The board has agreed to set up 7 email accounts.
2. Responsible Unit Recycling Ordinance #2026-100 was reviewed. Discussion held. Motion (Patenaude/Nowak) to approve and adopt Responsible Unity Recycling Ordinance #2026-100. Motion carried 5/0.

Plan Commission:

1. Discussion was held regarding a Public Hearing to change the zoning ordinances for A-1/R-1. Publications will run May 6 and 13, 2026 and a Public Hearing will be held on May 21, 2026 at 6pm.

Election:

1. Clerk Olson & Deputy Clerk Kaminski spoke on the Spring Election that was held April 7th. Supervisors Pellman & Zeitler were both re-elected into office for a new 2-year term and were sworn in.
