Public Input: Resident questioned who is responsible for road repair from heavy equipment. Road supervisor, Keith Brandes will be asked to access the damage and take pictures. Resident asked if a culvert is needed at the end of a driveway to prevent ice from building on the road.

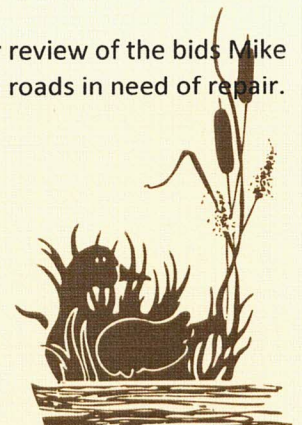

Open bids for Road/Culvert Work: Two bids were submitted for road projects for 2025. After review of the bids Mike Havlinek made a motion to accept the Scott Construction bid in the amount of \$188,540 for 13 roads in need of repair. Motion seconded by Derek Genske. Motion carried.

Spoke to county and there are no spacing requirements for No Parking signs on roads. Rear bumper on pickup is rusted and will be replaced. Installed LED light in town hall.



Topics for June 9, 2025 Board Meeting: Retail liquor and operator's license applications.

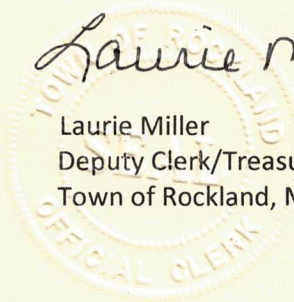
Meeting Adjourned: Derek Genske made motion to adjourn meeting at 8:07 p.m., second by Mike Havlinek, motion carried.
