License and Permits: None

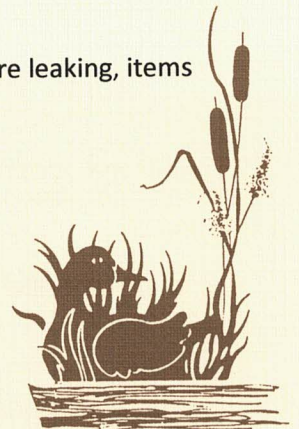
