Town of Rockland Annual Meeting Minutes Tuesday, April 21, 2026 7:00 P.M. @ Rockland Town Hall

Chairperson, Rosalie Geiger, called the annual meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Eleven (11) citizens signed in. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Rosalie reviewed the order of business and shared other topics could be added. Citizens were informed about the choice of ballots for various voting issues at the meeting. A show of hands was unanimously selected.

Secretary's report from the April 15, 2025 meeting was read by clerk Paula Winkel.

The Annual 2025 Audit and Budget report was reviewed and discussed. Time was given for all to review the year ending December 31, 2025 trial balance summary and to ask questions. Chairperson Geiger stated no new vehicles or major equipment purchases were made or sold in 2025 and the loan balance at the end of 2025 was \$233,700 with final payment year expected in 2029. Question was raised as to why we have paid for phragmites and do other towns in the county also contribute. Rosalie explained the board felt it was a good investment of funds to have this noxious/invasive species dealt with in our township.

Time was given for all to review the line-by-line 2026 budget and plans for awareness. No questions were asked.

Motion made by Dan Benter and second by Tim Thor to give the Board authority to borrow up to \$200,000, for a short-term loan, if needed in 2026. Motion carried with a show of hands for 11 Yay and 0 Nay.

Board wages were reviewed. No changes were recommended to annual Board salaries.

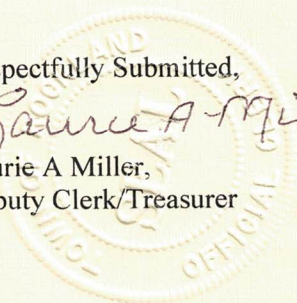
April 21, 2026 Annual meeting secretary's report was read by clerk Paula Winkel.
