

Town of Upham  
Monthly Meeting  
April 21, 2026

Chairman Stilen called the April meeting to order at 7:40 p.m. following the Annual Meeting. A full quorum was present including David Stilen, Randy Donovan, Glenn Dobrinska, Clerk Leah Antoniewicz, and seven registered visitors.

The Clerk read the minutes of the March 3<sup>rd</sup> Board Meeting. Chairman Stilen made a motion to approve the minutes. Supervisor Dobrinska seconded. Motion carried.

The Clerk read the Treasurer's report and reported the cash balance as of February 28, 2026, of \$391,284.68 with cash receipts as of March 31, 2026, of \$1,200.10 and cash disbursements as of March 31, 2026, of \$78,256.34 and a cash balance as of March 31, 2026, of \$314,228.44. Chairman Stilen made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report. Supervisor Donovan seconded. Motion carried.

Update on the Deepwood Dam-Waiting for downstream study. The deadline was missed to apply for the grant. We won't be able to apply again for two years. Update on the Greater Bass boat landing-the site survey is not done.

The Clerk presented the proposed five-year contract with Accurate Appraisal for consideration. The price increase is \$400.00 per year from \$17,900 to \$18,300.00 with an overall increase of \$2,000.00. Chairman Stilen made a motion to renew a five-year contact with Accurate Appraisal. Supervisor Dobrinska seconded. Motion carried.

The town board members will individually inspect town roads on May 5<sup>th</sup>.

Chairman Stilen made a motion to pay the bills. Supervisor Donovan seconded. Motion carried.
