

Town of Upham
Monthly Meeting
May 5, 2026

Chairman Stilen called the May meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. A full quorum was present including David Stilen, Randy Donovan, Glenn Dobrinska, Treasurer Tim Murphy, Clerk Leah Antoniewicz, and seven registered visitors.

The Clerk read the minutes of the April 21st Board Meeting. Chairman Stilen made a motion to approve the minutes. Supervisor Donovan seconded. Motion carried.

The Clerk read the Treasurer's report and reported the cash balance as of March 31, 2026, of \$314,228.44 with cash receipts as of April 30, 2026, of \$39,580.21 and cash disbursements as of April 30, 2026, of \$22,547.76 and a cash balance as of April 30, 2026, of \$331,260.89. Chairman Stilen made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report. Supervisor Dobrinska seconded. Motion carried.

Chairman Stilen reported that there was not much new on the Deepwood Dam other than that there is a lot of water going through it. Jed Mattmiller, project manager from Becher-Hoppe Associates, Inc., reported that the dam failure analysis (DFA) is not complete. The DFA is not required for any imminent funding deadlines but will be submitted to WiDNR by 9/1/2026. The survey to support the DFA was done in February, and can also be used in the meantime for design and construction info if the town decides to do the work themselves.

Jed Mattmiller reported on the Bass Lake boat landing. The site survey was done on April 24, 2026. He said that General Permit will require fill. Suggested that the low water mark should be used. May have to do an individual permit that will take more time. Fall would be a good time when the water level is lower. Possibly Labor Day weekend. That thought was rejected as many lake residents are taking their boats out for the winter. Jed said he would do a detail plan for us to get quotes.

Chairman Stilen gave the Road Report. The cost of oil may not allow us to blacktop. He would like to consider looking for bids for chip sealing. Many roads need gravel. Pleasant Acres Road is in very poor condition and needs to be completely redone. The potholes are getting filled in. Shouldering needs to be done in places. He will find out how much more gravel we can get hauled out of the pit.

Chairman Stilen made a motion to pay the bills. Supervisor Dobrinska seconded. Motion carried.

Chairman Stilen made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Donovan seconded
