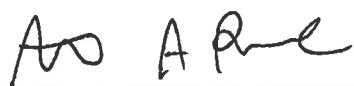


Town of Whitefield
Select Board Meeting Minutes
February 25, 2025

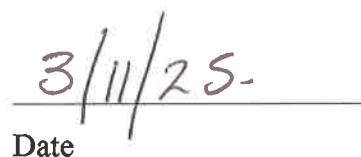
Present: Seth Bolduc (Chair), Keith Sanborn (Vice-Chair), Brent Hallowell, James Torbert, Brian O'Mahoney and Yolanda Violette.

1. The meeting was called to order by Seth Bolduc.
2. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of February 11. Motion carried 5-0.
3. Accounts payable and payroll warrants were approved and signed.
4. Yolanda reported to the board the recent hire to shovel snow at the town office and fire station has not been in contact and did not shovel the past storm. Yolanda is going to continue trying to find a reliable option.
5. Yolanda presented the board with an intent to sell notice for a piece of property located at Blue Goose Lane that the town has foreclosed on for 2022 taxes. A motion was made and seconded to sign the notice. Motion carried 5-0.
6. Yolanda has 7 properties that were recently foreclosed on for 2023 taxes. The board asked Yolanda to try other avenues to make contact to avoid sale of the properties. Yolanda will have an update at the first April meeting.
7. Seth informed the board he will be missing the March 11 and 25 meetings of the board due to work commitments.
8. The board reviewed the warrant articles for the annual town meeting and who would be addressing questions about them.
9. Seth spoke about starting the self-evaluation for the Community Resilience Partnership. The board has the self-evaluation forms and will start to consider strengths, weaknesses, long term and short term goals.
10. The board is going to invite Emily Rabbe executive director of Lincoln County Regional Planning Commission to a board meeting to discuss the organization and talk about a town representative to their board.
11. The board was invited to participate at household hazardous waste event at Hatch Hill again this year. There was concern by the board that last year the town was incorrectly charged, and not well attended by residents. The board will ask the opinion of the solid waste committee.
12. Yolanda reports the town's Trio budgetary software is having trouble and she is working with Trio to resolve the problem.

13. Yolanda reports tax maps on the website have been updated.
14. Keith reports the roads committee has talked about signage on each end of the Weary Pond Road.
Yolanda will notify Lincoln County Communications with information about which addresses are accessible from either end.
15. Meeting adjourned.

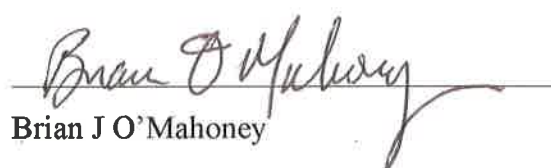
