May 19, 2026

1. Mr. Bolduc called the meeting to order.
2. Motion and second to approve the May 5 meeting minutes carried 5-0.
3. Approved and signed the Accounts Payable/Payroll Warrants.
4. Road Paving Bids – Bids were opened, read aloud and referred to the Roads Committee.

5. Roadside Brush Clearing Bids - Bids were opened, read aloud and referred to the Roads Committee.

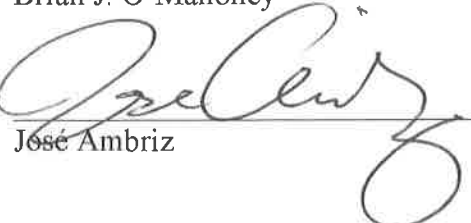

6. Cemetery Committee – An estimate was solicited from Mike Robertson to strip and paint a 50-foot section of metal fencing at the Coopers Mills Cemetery. Motion and second to approve the estimate of \$2,851.00 from Mike Robertson to be paid out of the Will Turner Cemetery Fund carried 4-0-1.
7. Will Turner Trust Petition – The petition to alter the terms of the Will Turner Cemetery Trust to expand the allowed use of the surplus funds for ancient burial grounds overseen by the town after the Coopers Mills Cemetery's needs have been satisfied is presented as the final to be sent to the attorney general. Motion and second to approve the petition to the Lincoln County Probate Court carried 5-0.
8. Olsen Property Sign – The sign proof was reviewed by The Board, minor changes made before being okayed for printing. Cost will be \$248.40.
9. Town Office Entryway Roofs – An estimate was solicited from Mike Robertson to finish the entryway roofs at the town office. Motion and second to approve the estimate from Mike Robertson for \$800.00 to finish the entryway roofs carried 5-0.
10. Roads – The Beaver expert from Vermont investigated the situation on Hollywood Boulevard. The expert identified two problems with potential avenues to address the issue, have a professionally designed deceiver installed and investigate what can be done about the dams downstream. Mr. Ambriz and Mr. Bolduc will investigate the culvert and attempt to clean it out. Mr. Hallowell will ask the beaver expert about an estimate and design for a deceiver. The verbal estimate is around \$4,000.
11. Correspondence – Kathleen Goetzman, of the Planning and School Boards, asked to be sent to a MMA Verbal Judo training at a cost of \$285.00. Motion and second to approve \$285.00 for the MMA training carried 5-0.
12. Chris Hamilton reached out to Mr. Bolduc and Mr. Ambriz about the presence of a dog at the Town Office.
13. Ms. Anderson inquired about having the planters in front of the Town Office done during the Day of Caring by the Whitefield Elementary on May 29.
14. Motion and second to adjourn carried 5-0.
