

**TOWN OF WITTENBERG, SHAWANO COUNTY**  
**Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes**  
**May 19, 2026**

The Town Board meeting was called to order by Chairman- Dick Beversdorf, at 6:02pm. Present besides the Chairman were Supervisor- Bill Timm, Supervisor- Justin Hartleben, Clerk- Maria Donat, Treasurer- Jasmine Wolff, Road Supervisors- Rick Hartleben and Tom Knaup, Dan Doyle, Angie Johnson, Kelly Schreurs and Cory Arndt.

Minutes from the regular Town Board Meeting on April 21, 2026 were read. A Motion was made by Timm and seconded by Beversdorf to accept them as read. Motion carried.

Minutes from the Special Meeting on May 13, 2026 were read. A Motion was made by Timm and seconded by Beversdorf to accept them as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report was given and will stand as presented. Balances in the accounts are as follows: NOW Account = \$44,758.58; MMDA Account = \$82,838.53; Gardner Park Account = \$184,313.94; and Tax Account = \$198,520.36.

A Motion was made by Timm and seconded by Beversdorf to deviate from the Agenda order. Motion carried.

Coach Cory Arndt came to speak on behalf of the Wittenberg-Biramwood Area Youth Football (& Cheer) program. Arndt stated the program has 70 kids signed up for football and 25 kids signed up for cheerleading. Arndt also stated the program needs helmets reconditioned, team jerseys and new uniforms for the cheerleaders.

Angie Johnson came to speak on behalf of the Wittenberg Area Chamber of Commerce. Johnson thanked the Town Board for becoming Chamber members and informed the board about some new events happening during the upcoming Community Days, such as a kid's "Bike Give-A-Way."

Maple Hills Golf Course manager, Kelly Schreurs, came to express concerns about the traffic on Cardinal Lane during busy golf events. The board discussed several options with Schreurs. Additionally, Beversdorf & Schreurs will be looking into potential solutions and other measures to assist during busy golf events.

The Clerk shared an email she received from Wittenberg Little League's new president on the condition of the Little League ball field facilities.

Road bids from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers, LLC were opened and read.

A Motion was made by Hartleben and seconded by Timm to accept Fahrner Asphalt's Crack Filling bid for \$2.36 per pound. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Hartleben and seconded by Timm to accept Fahrner Asphalt's Chip Sealing bid at \$27,810.00 per mile. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Hartleben and seconded by Timm to accept Fahrner Asphalt's Spray Patching bid at \$5,440.00 a day. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Hartleben and seconded by Timm to Approve the monthly bills & payroll checks numbered 12770 through 12805. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Timm and seconded by Hartleben to Approve a 6-month Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage License to Wittenberg Little League. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Timm and seconded by Hartleben to Approve Resolution No.: 2026-5-19 "Resolution to Adopt the County Ordinance Regulating All-Terrain and Utility Vehicles." Motion carried.

The Town Board discussed the vacant Animal Control Officer position. As the position has remained unfilled since March despite 6-weeks of advertising, the Board has decided to refund the 6 contracted entities for the months of March through December 2026. Effective today, May 19, 2026, the Town of Wittenberg's Animal Control Department is no longer active, and all existing contracts are now void.

A Motion was made by Timm and seconded by Hartleben to Approve a \$1,000.00 donation to the Wittenberg Chamber of Commerce for the 2026 Community Days event. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Hartleben and seconded by Timm to approve a \$5,000.00 donation to the Wittenberg-Birnamwood Area Youth Football program payable from the town's Occupancy Tax funds. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Timm and seconded by Hartleben to adjourn the town meeting at 7:19pm. Motion carried.
