

TOWN OF YORK, DANE COUNTY

MINUTES – August 19, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of York was called to order by Chairman Helwig at 6:00 pm. Those present were Chairman Helwig, Supervisor David Auchtung, Supervisor Jamie Derr and Clerk/Treasurer, Linda Henning.

Posting of the agenda and meeting notice was verified by the Clerk/Treasurer.

There was no public input.

Approval of the Agenda: Motion by Supervisor Derr with a second from Supervisor Auchtung. Agenda approved with all present in favor.

Minutes of July 8, 2024: Motion by Supervisor Derr with a second from Supervisor Auchtung to approve of the minutes of July 8, 2024. Minutes approved with all present in favor.

Clerk's Report: Election results for the August 12th election were 206 voters cast their ballot. A propane contract was received from FS Insight for fuel for the coming winter season at \$4.99/gallon. This will be on the September agenda for approval. There were no building permit fees for the month of August.

Treasurer's Report: The Board members reviewed the monthly treasurer's report. Motion to pay bills check number 9222 through check number 9235 and hold other checks until the second half payment of taxes was received. Motion approved with all present in favor.

New Business/Reports:

Priem Road Flooding: Priem Road is flooding over because the culvert is higher than the ditch. Water is flooding the field alongside Priem Road. Suggestions were made to Jason Priem of possible solutions. He will check these out.

Patrolman's Report: Written report submitted by Patrolman Dan Kleven.

Marshall & Columbus Fire/EMS: Referendum was discussed. Towns with populations under 2500 do not need to do a referendum. A higher levy may be approved by the electors at a public hearing. Motion by Chairman Helwig with a second from Supervisor Derr to table increasing the Town levy in 2025 until the September meeting. The Board will pass a resolution at that meeting.

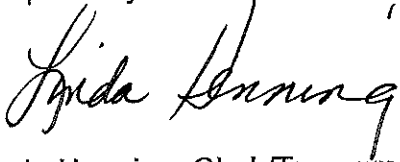
A budget update was reviewed by the Board.
