Minutes of Board Meeting
held Monday April 20, 2026 at 6:30 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Town Chairman, Eric Hau. Those present were Supervisors Barbara Hollander and Brian Madigan, Treasurer Rose Riedeman, Clerk Karen Smit and residents Terry Madigan and Bob and Cindy Schulz

Resident, Terry Madigan was present to request the board consider lowering the speed limit on all town roads to 45 mph

Minutes of the March 16, 2026 board meeting were approved on a motion by B. Hollander, second by E. Hau and unanimously carried.

Invoice listing for the month of April was reviewed and approved on a motion by B. Madigan, second B. Hollander and unanimously carried.

- Board reviewed the proposal from Town Web for a new website platform. Motion by B. Hollander, second by B. Madigan to accept the proposal as presented. Motion unanimously carried.

New Business:

- The DNR recently implemented a recycling rule revision and required every responsible unit pass a new recycling ordinance. The DNR provided a template, and the board customized a few areas pertaining to where/how residents can recycle locally. Upon completion, a motion was made by B. Madigan to approve Ordinance #1-2026 titled "Responsible Unit Recycling Ordinance". Motion second by B. Hollander and unanimously passed.

New Business Continued:

- Recently Transcendent Technologies announced the ability for municipalities to offer online payment processing to taxpayers. Treasurer, Rose Riedeman researched 2 credit card processing vendors and provided a handout detailing both companies. A motion was made by B. Hollander to contract with Deluxe for online payments. Motion second by B. Madigan and unanimously carried.
- Following an update on the road review, a motion was made by B. Madigan to post for bids the areas noted for repair in 2026. Motion was second by B. Hollander and unanimously carried.
- Motion made by B. Madigan to sign contract with Fond du lac Humane Society, motion seconded by B. Hollander and unanimously carried.
