Minutes of Board Meeting
held Monday, July 21, 2025 at 6:30 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Town Chairman, Eric Hau. Those present were Supervisors Barbara Hollander and Brian Madigan via speaker phone, Treasurer Rose Riedeman, Deputy Clerk Pat Heyer.

The minutes of the June 19, 2025 board meeting were approved on a motion by B. Hollander, second by B. Madigan and unanimously carried.

Updates/contact by Supervisors:

Old Business:

- Regarding flooring at Town Hall: Eric has not heard back from Green Lake Flooring, but he will try once more before attempting to get an estimate from somewhere else.

New Business:

- Following discussion, a motion was made by B. Madigan to fix the 150' x 10' section of Towne Road and split the cost with Brett Colien. Motion second by B. Hollander and unanimously carried.

Highway Matter:
