Minutes of Board Meeting
held Monday November 17, 2025 at 6:30 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Town Chairman, Eric Hau. Those present were Supervisors Barbara Hollander and Brian Madigan, Treasurer Rose Riedeman, Residents Randall and Karen Pollock, Myron and Jenelle Giffey and Clerk Karen Smit.

Visitors:

Randall and Karen Pollock were present to discuss concerns about a shed being built at N5601 Center Road and questions about the septic system.

Myron and Jenelle Giffey were present to hear the outcome of their re-zone application and Certified Survey Map.

Terry Alexander, Program Coordinator for Envision Greater Fond du Lac was present to introduce herself and to leave information about the Organization.

The minutes of the October 23, 2025 board meeting were approved on a motion by B. Hollander, second by B. Madigan and unanimously carried.

Invoice listing for the month of November was reviewed and approved on a motion by B. Madigan, second B. Hollander and unanimously carried.

Treasurer, Rose Riedeman presented the Treasurer's Report for the month of October 2025 and updated balances for board review.

- Contacted Mr. Jackowski regarding his dual zoned property, Mr. Jackowski would like to rezone the entire parcel to rural residential.

Town Chairman letter & notices:

- Board reviewed the spreadsheet sent by Brandon/Fairwater Fire Department that detailed the price of new tender truck and percentage due by each entity. Motion by B. Madigan, second by B. Hollander to agree with the tentative budget and Springvale's assessment portion as detailed in the spreadsheet sent by email on October 30, 2025. Motion unanimously carried.
- Fond du Lac County contacted Chairman Hau regarding an abandoned boat filled with tires. The responsible party has been identified. Chairman will follow up with FDL County regarding possible restitution.

Old Business: None

New Business:

- A motion was made by B. Madigan, second by B. Hollander and unanimously carried to continue to use the Fond du Lac County sales and use tax dollars in the amount of \$14,800.00 to offset the rising cost of garbage and recycling. The special assessment placed on the tax bills will remain at \$125.00 for current year.

New Business Continued:

- Prior to the regular board meeting, the budget hearing and special meeting of taxpayers was held. Motion made by B. Hollander to adopt the proposed 2026 budget as presented. Motion was second by B. Madigan and unanimously carried. (Township levy adopted at the special meeting of the electors is \$189,528.00).
- At the recommendation of the Plan Commission, a motion was made by B. Hollander, second by B. Madigan to approve the rezone application and Certified Survey Map for Myron Giffey. Motion unanimously carried.
- No action was taken regarding financial support for Envision Greater Fond du Lac.
