

MINUTES
Twin Lakes Township
Wednesday, September 3, 2025
Town Board Meeting at the Twin Lakes Town Hall
5:00 p.m.

Board Chair Diane Felde-Finke opened the meeting at 5:00 p.m. Other board members present: Supervisor Randy Willie, Supervisor Mike Orlowski, Treasurer Cortney Carlson, Clerk Sue Chapin, Deputy Clerk Daisy Rose. Also present: Road Foreman Bob Olean and Joel Reed.

Guests:

John Korienek: The fallen trees that were close to the road on West Chub Lake Road have been removed. Various maintenance on other roads was completed.

Derek Wolf, City of Carlton: Nelson's will be cleaning sewer lines and the lift station in September. Buller, on Schmitz Road, is getting hooked up to the water line this month, DeCaigny Excavating is completing the work. Ulland Brothers is restarting the FDL grow facility project off of Highway 210. Ehlers continues to work on our rate study and has asked if there are any capital projects in the next 10 years. There is potential for growth on the county land near the Justice Center but nothing definite or with a dollar amount attached to it. Also, it is an unknown who would be responsible for payment of any possible projects.

MOTION to approve the August 20, 2025 town board meeting minutes as printed was made by Willie and seconded by Orlowski; all voted yes, the motion passed.

MOTION to pay all bills, check numbers 19364 - 19368 and electronic payments BANK25JUL and 941SEP25 for the total amount of \$57,724.39 was made by Willie and seconded by Orlowski; all voted yes, the motion passed.

Carlson presented the treasurer's report.

- Cologne Road: Still waiting on shouldering.
- Paving Projects: No updates.
- Old East Chub Lake Road: Olean looked into the section of road/ditch and found no current issues, it is not soft nor flooding, so it does not need to be addressed at this time.
- Lac La Belle Road: Olean reported that the patch at the end of Lac LaBelle Road will be done this fall, Kiminski has not given an exact date for completion.
- Insurance Claim: A claim for pothole damage on East Chub Lake Road has been filed with our insurance company, and they are investigating the matter.

- Lakes and Pines Grant: The township board and Lakes and Pines agree to close out the grant.

- Evergreen Drive: Olean received a quote for completing the full 1,300 feet of overlay which would cost \$44,750.00. **MOTION to approve overlay work on Evergreen Drive for \$44,750.00, pending there is not a significant cost overage on our current paving projects, was made by Felde-Finke and seconded by Orlowski; all voted yes, the motion passed.**

- Hay Lake Road: Felde-Finke reported that there is a pothole on Hay Lake Road, Olean will check it out.
