Discussion on Village drive around

Chairman Pierce stated that there are 3 properties in the Village that need to have nuisance letters sent out to, 406 Quincy Street, 205 East Lake Street, 108 East Lake Street.

Update on meter installs

Frank stated that Hydro Corp finished today (4/25/2024). There are residents that didn't make appointments even though both Brent and the installers from Hydro Corp called, and red tagged their doors. Now Frank will need to finish up the installation. He thinks there's around 60 left to do. Frank is going to find out from the PSC if he can shut off the water if they don't make an appointment after a certified letter is sent out.

Hwy 13 road and lighting project update

No update. Frank has a meeting with the DOT and Contractors in Wisconsin Rapids on April 26th. He also stated that on Tuesday April 30th in the Village Hall from 5-7 PM there will be a public meeting.
