Plan Commission Meeting

Monday, March 2, 2026

The Plan Commission for the Village of Grantsburg met on Monday, March 2, 2026, at 4:00p.m. in the Village Board Room, 316 S. Brad Street, Grantsburg, Wisconsin.

Call to Order Chairman/President Lindberg called the Plan Commission meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Hearing- CUP A Conditional Use Permit application was received from Beau Carey, owner of 497 State Road 70 East, to sell sheds on his property. Chairman/President Lindberg called the Public Hearing to order at 4:03 p.m. Clerk/Treasurer Meyer read the Public Hearing Notice. Chairman/President Lindberg asked for anyone wishing to speak in favor of the CUP application. Dane Carey, brother of Beau Carey, was present and explained they would like to contract with Premier Sheds to display between eight (8) and fifteen (15) of Premier's sheds on the lot at 497 St Rd 70 E. The sheds would be very neatly arranged with signage that would meet Village Ordinance. Individuals would use the driveway farthest to the east to enter the site and exit from the driveway to the west. There would be ample parking space available. The sheds would be for display purposes and interested people would call Premier to order their desired shed be built to their specifications. Chairman/President Lindberg asked for anyone wishing to speak against the CUP application. No one spoke. The Public Hearing was closed at 4:09 p.m.

Motion by Member Blomberg, second by Member Myers, to recommend the Village Board approve the Conditional Use Permit application submitted by Beau Carey, owner of 497 State Road 70 East (parcel 07-131-2-38-19-23-1 01-000-011000) to display sheds on his property. Motion passed unanimously.
