Regular Meeting Minutes, July 13, 2026 - Village Hall

Call to Order

The regular meeting of the Village Board, for the Village of Marquette, was called to order by President Cybul at 7:00p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Certification of Compliance with the Open Meetings Law: Agenda notice was posted in three public places - Village Hall door, kiosks at the Post Office and Truck Garage, and will be posted on the Village Website.

Approve Agenda

A motion to approve the agenda was made. Michalos/Deiss. Motion passed. (Unanimous).

Approval of Minutes sent to Board Members: All minutes are posted on the Village Website and in the kiosks as a draft for the Board and the public to review. No changes made. A motion was made to approve the minutes as presented. Deiss/Michalos. Motion passed. (Unanimous).

Reading and Approval of Treasurer's Report

Approve Payment of Bills: Presented for payment were vouchers 1404-1427 in the amount of \$10,426.12 plus \$4,500.00 for the maintained balance and utilities for a Grand total of \$14,926.12. Motion to pay the bills as presented and transfer from the appropriate accounts the amount of \$14,500.00 to the General Fund. Deiss/Michalos. Motion passed. (Unanimous).

Rudy Winters asked if the board knew of time limit of cement pad to be poured by Historical building. No ETA. He also confirmed the hall rental for September for the Historical Society.

Discuss / Approve

Guest speaker Taylor Haag Strauser spoke regarding the surrounding lakes economic impact study has on Green Lake County. She also would like her information forwarded to other lake rehabilitation groups in the area so they can work together to improve our lake systems.

LRIP Road Projects

Fahrner Asphalt can do the prep work as the county could not do it in time for an August time frame. Road prep cost \$6,880.00.

Scott Construction will do the double chip seal in August for \$23,397.36.

The motion was made to approve the \$30,277.36 project. Michalos/Deiss. Motion passed. (Unanimous)

Lawn ordinance violators

Violation notices have been sent out from the board and it seems that there are repeat offenders every season. Our attorney is being consulted on making the violations to run yearly with stiffer fines. The village is also looking at hiring a landscaper to mow or clean up these properties and then the charges will be billed back to the homeowner. The board gets repeated complaints regarding properties in the Village that are bringing down property values.
