Regular Meeting Minutes, August 10, 2026 - Village Hall

Call to Order

The regular meeting of the Village Board, for the Village of Marquette, was called to order by President Cybul at 7:00p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

There were 4 citizens in attendance.

Certification of Compliance with the Open Meetings Law: Agenda notice was posted in three public places - Village Hall door, kiosks at the Post Office and Truck Garage, and will be posted on the Village Website.

Approve Agenda

A motion to approve the agenda was made. Michalos/Deiss. Motion passed. (Unanimous).

Approval of Minutes sent to Board Members: All minutes are posted on the Village Website and in the kiosks as a draft for the Board and the public to review. No changes made. A motion was made to approve the minutes as presented. Deiss/Michalos. Motion passed. (Unanimous).

Reading and Approval of Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's report was read. Motion to approve the treasurer's report as read. Michalos/Deiss. Motion passed. (Unanimous).

Approve Payment of Bills: Presented for payment were vouchers 1428-1445 in the amount of \$18,161.76 plus \$4,500.00 for the maintained balance and utilities for a Grand total of \$22,661.76. Motion to pay the bills as presented and transfer from the appropriate accounts the amount of \$22,300.00 to the General Fund. Deiss/Michalos. Motion passed. (Unanimous).

Citizen Comments – Time Limits and Rules Apply:

Janet Burdick expressed concerns about high weeds at the edge of her property and where her lawn service would not mow. President Cybul expressed concern that residents have let the weeds get too large along 2nd street and it is now out of control. He will be meeting with Derek Mashuda and visiting the sites where it is uncontrollable. The Village will then address this issue with residents to clean up their property or the Village will fine them if we have to hire someone to come in and do the work.

Deb Flagel wanted to know if the Village will purchase additional tables for events at the Village Hall. President Cybul said it should be up to the organization to purchase these items and are welcome to leave them at the hall.

Discuss / Approve**LRIP Road Projects Update**

Fahrner Asphalt has done the preliminary work for the double asphalt seal but the Village will have to post a new LRIP bid request for 2 weeks and then resubmit the application for work to be done in the spring.

Weeds, Ditch Lines & Property conditions

The weeds have gotten out of control throughout the Village after the new road and easement was installed. Derek Mashuda will see what the county can correct and what the homeowners need to do to correct the problems. Residents will have 7 days to correct ditch lines on their properties once notified.
