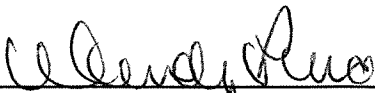
BUSINESS:

a. Consent Agreement

Manager DuPont will email copies of the red line version as soon as it is received and the Council will review the agreement at Monday's meeting.
