

Hi Laurie,

Yes, attached is our recommendation for Archeologic Study to clear the site flagged by the DNR.

There are two prices listed. The lower price is for a "Pedestrian Survey" meaning 30% or greater ground visibility is available and no digging is required. The higher price is for a "Shovel Survey" meaning there is too much ground cover and the consultant needs to dig holes at certain increments to investigate.

As we discussed before, if the Village can coordinate with the farmer to mow & possibly till the area to be surveyed, the lower number can be assumed as the final cost for the Arch Survey.

This proposal was combined the most cost effective, ability to be onsite soon after approval of the contract and quick estimated turnaround on both the inspection & report.
