I've spoken with Tim and Tom about this bill. Tim provided me with a detailed billing and upon review it seems to have some overlap with work the village ordered. I spoke with Tom again yesterday.

When the village annexed the airport evidently they had no provision in their zoning for an airport. In all fairness the village should have made the necessary changes to accommodate that use as it has been an airport for over 75 years. That having not been done has lead to additional costs to the airport and it's tenants.

When I spoke with Tom yesterday I suggested a compromise where the airport would cover 1/2 of the bill minus the interest. If that is agreeable I will present that at our next commission meeting in March. I believe the commission would approve it.
