

## **PUBLIC WORKS MONTHLY REPORT**

The PFAS Treatment Plant project will have its construction kick-off meeting at the end of the month.

We cleaned up most of the snowplow damaged sides of the road. We didn't put the dirt back in a lot of the places because it was too high to begin with. We will reseed some of those spots later this spring.

We had our big 5-year inspection of the sewer plant. Our discharge permit expired at the end of the year. They have not issued a new one yet. They are going to change some of our discharge limits and we will get a compliance schedule on when we have to meet the new limits. We may have to make some small upgrades to the plant to meet the new limits. We have to start testing for PFAS in the effluent and in the sludge which could affect the cost of sludge disposal.

Other things going on this month.

- The Vac truck broke down when we were trying to hydro-excavate water laterals on First St. to see what ones we have to replace before the street project. We are waiting to get an estimate for repairs.
- Letters and estimates will be going out to residents that will be affected by this year's sidewalk project.
- We will be opening the village park sometime in the next week, depending on weather conditions.
