Good Afternoon,

Our engine has returned from the repair shop and is back in service for all assignments. You may see it around town pumping at various locations as crews train and re-familiarize themselves with it.

We have 3 new employees. two are part-time/paid-on-call EMT's and live in the village. One is certified and the other is obtaining her license. The 3rd is a part-time FF/EMT, lives in Muskego and comes with experience from the Tess Corners Fire district.

We have 1 part-time FF/EMT on a leave of absence as he has started a full-time FF/EMT job. He will return at the end of his probationary period. We also have an employee that will be on a leave of absence starting in the middle of May. She is in the Army National Guard and has been deployed for a year. We will welcome her return when her tour of duty is complete.

The fire at the chicken farm was an overall success. Although they lost the building, it could have potentially been much worse. We had a good percentage of our employees on scene and were assisted by many outside organizations to bring it under control in a timely fashion.

Our new ambulance was started on the 28th of April. We have started contacting vendors for graphics. We will obtain multiple quotes for their installation. We have also reached out to local vendors for the installation of our mobile radio(s) and light programming. Multiple requests for that will be obtained as well.
