***Monthly report April 2026***

- ✓ I want to say that Heather Hazlett, new Deputy Clerk/Treasurer is working out VERY well. She takes initiative, isn't afraid to learn new things, very personable and a pleasure to work with.
- ✓ The April 7<sup>th</sup> Election went well. We had about a 34% voter turn out. The next election is the Partisan Primary in August.
- ✓ Dee Dee has the new water rates entered into Workhorse for the billing that will go out in June. We have also been working on the billing for the Public Fire Protection charges. Any parcels owned by the same owner that are adjoining will not be getting an addition charge. This may not sound like much, but it requires looking at A LOT of parcels in the GIS mapping (ex. Standard Process) to determine how many get charges and how may do not. Very time consuming.
- ✓ Zoning Code has been updated with the last few ordinance changes that have happened. Everyone will be getting their books updated as soon they turn them into please.
- ✓ We are still taking Village court citation payments and we have received a few hundred dollars from Lake County Court for the month of March.
- ✓ Liquor license renewal packets have gone out electronically this year to the establishments.
- ✓ I took 2 half days of alcohol licensing training April 30<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>.
