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Police Division

The Police Division remained very active during the month of **July**, responding to **83 calls for service (including traffic stops)**. Year-to-date, the Division has responded to **773 calls for service**, compared to **343** at the same point last year—an **increase of approximately 125%**, or **more than double** the activity experienced during the same period in 2025. This increase continues to reflect proactive traffic enforcement, officer-initiated activity, and a growing demand for police services within the Village.

During the month of July, officers made **at least six arrests** for various offenses including **OWI** and issued **multiple disorderly conduct citations**. Officers also investigated incidents involving **criminal damage to property, trespassing complaints, and fireworks-related complaints** surrounding the Fourth of July holiday. Despite the increase in calls for service, the holiday period was relatively uneventful, with no significant public safety incidents.

In addition to enforcement activities, department personnel participated in **multiple community outreach and public relations events**, continuing to strengthen relationships with residents while maintaining a visible and proactive police presence throughout the Village.
