Minutes

Committee reviewed the February 12, 2025 Public Works minutes. *Motion by Garn, second by Krohn to approve the February 12, 2025 Public Works meeting minutes and motion carried.*

Public Comment

- Chris Halle ~ In favor of a dog park, just not at LaGrandeur Disk Golf.
- Deb Kohler ~ Could have a dog park around the hockey rink area, not at Village Park.

Project Updates

General Updates on Active Projects: A project update memo was provided.

- TID #5 Lift Station & Utility Extension ~ Schwartz updated the committee about the State stepping in and getting the County involved. The DOT, County & Village will have a meeting.
- Winesap Prairie ~ There are some erosion control and disturbances that need to be addressed. Gunther will reach out to the DNR.

Unfinished Business

Motion by Garn, second by Krohn to schedule May 7th at 6pm and a rain date of May 8th for the Timeline on Meetings with the Public on Village Park Improvements and motion carried.

New Business

AT & T Lease Renewal: A handout was provided.

- Gunther explained that AT & T has towers on our downtown water tower.
- The attorney is reviewing the legal language.
- After much discussion, they will submit a counteroffer.

Motion by Garn, second by Krohn to recommend to the Village Board option 3 with the caveat of increasing the additional cost of \$600.00 to \$660.00 per month fee and index the same percentage increase every 5 years as the rent starting effective 2026 with a 25 year lease and motion carried.

Water Tower No. 1 Reconditioning Proposal – KLM Engineering: A proposal was provided.

Motion by Kern, second by Krohn to recommend to the Village Board approval of the Water Tower No. 1 Reconditioning Proposal – KLM Engineering as presented, and motion carried.

Pickle Ball Quote – Larry Forrest: Quotes were provided.

- Kern would like to get this done this year. If the lower quote can't get to it fast enough, would like to spend the extra \$2300.00 to have the other guy do it so we can utilize the courts this year. This would come back to the committee

Motion by Krohn, second by Garn to recommend to the Village Board approval of Court Surfaces & Repair, Inc. in the amount of \$29,650.00 (to get to it as soon as possible) and motion carried.

Discussion from Kern, it should happen this summer. If it's not going to happen in 2025 then it should come back to the Board or this committee for other consideration.

TID #5 Lift Station & Utility Extension Task Order #1: A task order was provided.

- Gunther & Schwartz will go back over the task order to get a summary of the charges.

Motion by Kern, second by Krohn to table TID #5 Lift Station & Utility Extension Task Order #1 to next month and motion carried.

TID #5 LIFT STATION & UTILITY EXTENSION

Haas Sons, Inc. installed the lift station structure and are waiting for approval on the proposed sanitary sewer drop manhole #1. WisDOT is working with St Croix County and the contractor to perform additional exploration in locating the casing pipes shown on WisDOT's as built plan. An on-site meeting is tentatively scheduled for next week to discuss completed Village explorations and next locations to excavate.

REQUESTED ACTION:

Public Works to consider recommending the time and expenses task order approval for an estimated fee of \$77,300 for additional construction-related services. The Board to consider approval at their April 15th meeting.

TID #5 – LATITUDE 45 DEVELOPMENT

Dan's Excavating has installed the water main, sanitary sewer and storm sewer in the development. The crew plans to work on the utility connections and roadway realignment at Parent Street/180th Ave in mid-April. The developer's engineer (AEC) will provide a traffic control plan for the Village to review and comment on prior to any roadway disturbance.

PINE VALE FIRST ADDITION

 - Verify that tests, equipment, and systems start-ups are conducted and documented appropriately.
 - Maintain orderly files and prepare a daily report recording Contractor's hours and activities at the site.
 - Review applications for payment with regard to Work completed, and materials and equipment delivered at the Site.
 - Participate in visits to the Project to determine punch list items, and readiness for Substantial Completion and Final Completion.
 - Updates to Owner's electronic Geographic Information System to reflect changes from project.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

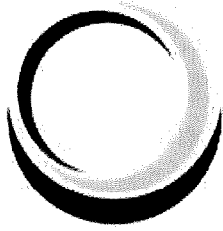

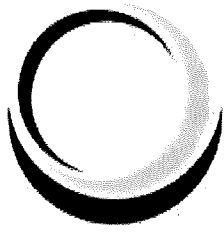

NOTICE OF LIEN RIGHTS

AS REQUIRED BY THE WISCONSIN CONSTRUCTION LIEN LAWS, CONTRACTOR HEREBY NOTIFIES OWNER THAT PERSONS OR COMPANIES FURNISHING LABOR OR MATERIALS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION ON OWNER'S LAND MAY HAVE LIEN RIGHTS ON OWNER'S LAND AND BUILDING IF NOT PAID. THOSE ENTITLED TO LIEN RIGHTS, IN ADDITION TO THE UNDERSIGNED CONTRACTOR, ARE THOSE WHO CONTRACT DIRECTLY WITH THE OWNER OR THOSE WHO GIVE THE OWNER NOTICE WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS AFTER THEY FIRST FURNISH LABOR OR MATERIALS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION. ACCORDINGLY, OWNER PROBABLY WILL RECEIVE NOTICES FROM THOSE WHO FURNISH LABOR OR MATERIALS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, AND SHOULD GIVE A COPY OF EACH NOTICE RECEIVED TO THE MORTGAGE LENDER, IF ANY. CONTRACTOR AGREES TO COOPERATE WITH THE OWNER AND THE OWNER'S LENDER, IF ANY, TO SEE THAT ALL POTENTIAL LIEN CLAIMS ARE DULY PAID.

ACCEPTANCE OF WORK

All labor and material is conclusively accepted as satisfactory unless accepted to in writing within seven (7) days of performance.

EXTRA WORK

All alterations or deviations from any of the terms of this contract shall be in writing and executed by the parties hereto. Any extra cost involved therein will become an extra charge to be paid by PURCHASER over and above the contract price.

PURCHASER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

PURCHASER acknowledges and understands that it shall be responsible for obtaining any and all permits which may be required in connection with performance of this Proposal/Contract. Where applicable, PURCHASER shall also be responsible for backfilling areas that border along the newly paved surface with appropriate material to eliminate potential cracking and uneven surface at the edge of the paved surface and for installing, replacing, maintaining and repairing shoulders. PURCHASER assumes all liability for any damages done to underground utilities and/or structures unless CONTRACTOR has been notified, upon acceptance of this Proposal, as to the specific location and depth of any such buried utility/structures.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Inclement weather may alter the completion of the work to be furnished hereunder. Furthermore, special consideration should be given if work is to be performed before May 1 or after October 15 in light of less than desirable weather conditions which could potentially impair the quality of the work performed hereunder.

WARRANTY

All material is guaranteed to be as specified and all work is to be completed in a workmanlike manner according to standard practices. All labor and materials will be guaranteed against defect for one (1) year from date of installation. Due to Wisconsin winters and expansion and contraction of the ground, some cracking of the pavement may be experienced. There are no express or implied warranties of merchantability, quality, and quantity or of fitness for any particular purpose, which extend beyond those specifically set out in this document.

All warranties are void if payment is not made as stipulated.

DELINQUENCY CHARGE

Payment is due and payable upon completion of each stage of the work. If PURCHASER defaults on the payment required, PURCHASER will be liable for all costs of collection, including reasonable attorney's fees, and a delinquency charge on the balance at the maximum rates allowed by law. If PURCHASER is an organization as defined by Wis. Statutes, Section 421.301(28), the Delinquency Charge rate shall be 1.5% per month (18% APR) plus all costs of collection, including reasonable attorney's fees. CONTRACTOR retains title to all merchandise covered by this Agreement until full payment is received according to the above terms of sale. PURCHASER consents in any action or legal proceeding relating to this Contract commenced by the CONTRACTOR to the personal jurisdiction of any court that is either a court of record in the State of Wisconsin or a court of the United States located in the State of Wisconsin. It is hereby agreed that no legal action with respect to this contract may be brought by either party later than one (1) year after the cause of action accrues and that the party asserting such a legal action shall be barred from any remedy thereto.

INDIVIDUAL LIABILITY

The undersigned PURCHASER agrees to be individually liable for all terms of the Agreement, regardless of whether he or she signs individually or as an agent for the owner of the property upon which the work is being performed or for any other individual, partnership or corporation.

PRODUCT INFORMATION AND MAINTENANCE

Since the asphalt in blacktop needs time to harden and cure, usually 6-12 months, your asphalt pavement will remain soft and pliable during warm weather. During this time, don't park in the same spot every time and do not turn your steering wheel back and forth when your car is not moving. It is not unusual to experience some cracking over the winter due to the contraction and expansion of the ground, especially over culverts, pipes, electric wires, etc. Avoid gasoline and petroleum product spills as they will destroy your pavement. If spills do occur, immediately flush with lots of soapy water. If you decide to seal coat your pavement, wait until the summer following installation.

BINDING EFFECT

This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

The entire contract is embodied in this writing. This writing constitutes the final expression of the party's agreement, and is a complete and exclusive statement of that agreement. In the event that any term of this contract is unenforceable, the remaining terms of the contract shall still be in full force and effect.

Sewer Utility:

Things are working well at the wastewater treatment plant.

Water Utility:

We received notification from the DNR that the utility is non-compliant with its lead and copper inventory reporting. I am working with them to see exactly what they need from us and what was wrong with our prior submittal. We are required to send a notification to customers as a requirement from the EPA. The most important thing to know is that we do not have any pipes manufactured with lead in our entire system, so there is no health concerns to our customers. I will update you as I learn more about what we need to do to satisfy our inventory reporting.

Streets:

We received mill and over lay quotes from Monarch Paving on various streets. This will be a good estimate of costs to do the work on our streets. We are required to post request for proposals for any project over \$25,000 so once we know what streets we would like to consider for mill and overlay we can get something published. I suggest considering micro-surfacing Main street. This basically provides a thin layer of emulsified aggregate that is applied after filling ruts and cracks. It is a good cost alternative to mill and overlay depending on the street conditions.

Parks:

The baseball and softball seasons have started. Staff will be doing spring maintenance on our parks once we have more stable weather.

We may need to pull the multi-use trail section from 190th due to property owner's not willing to participate in the right-of-way acquisition. The remaining trail segments are staying as planned.
