RESOLUTION NO. 2025-07

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO IMPLEMENT TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL MEASURES FOR LARGE-SCALE EVENTS

WHEREAS, the Village of Somerset regularly accommodates large-scale public events held at the privately owned Somerset Amphitheater via an Interim Conditional Use Permit (ICUP), which frequently draw crowds exceeding 10,000 attendees; and

WHEREAS, such events cause significant traffic impacts that exceed the capacity of the village's road infrastructure and present risks to public safety, emergency access, and general traffic operations; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes § 349.03(3) authorizes local authorities to implement temporary traffic regulations during emergencies or special conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board seeks to support safe, lawful, and coordinated traffic management during such events;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Board of the Village of Somerset, St. Croix County, Wisconsin:

1. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and empowered to implement temporary traffic regulations during permitted large-scale public events within the Village of Somerset.
2. These regulations may include, but are not limited to:
 - Temporary lane closures
 - One-way traffic designations
 - Zipper merge patterns
 - Road access restrictions for non-emergency vehicles
3. All such changes shall be:
 - Coordinated with Public Works and emergency services, including the Somerset Fire Department and EMS providers, to ensure uninterrupted emergency response capabilities.
 - Documented and communicated in advance when possible.
 - Effective only for the duration necessary to support event operations and public safety.

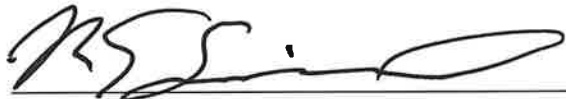

- In the event of unforeseen obstacles to implementing the approved traffic control plan (e.g., equipment failure, public safety hazard, or major congestion), the Chief of Police shall be authorized to implement reasonable alternative measures in the field to preserve public safety and traffic flow, in coordination with Public Works and other emergency services as appropriate.
4. Following each large-scale event, the Police Department shall conduct a post-event review of the temporary traffic control measures in coordination with other relevant departments and stakeholders. This review shall assess ingress and egress times, traffic incident reports, emergency response impacts, and public feedback to evaluate effectiveness and identify areas for improvement in future events.
