

Tiskilwa Village Board Agenda
Special Meeting Tuesday, September 2, 2025

The Tiskilwa Village Board met in Special Session Tuesday, September 2, 2025 at the Tiskilwa Fire Station at 7:00 p.m. Answering roll call were Mayor Daniel Acker, Trustees Kayla Kunkel, James Cole, Brett Klinefelter, Dan Yepsen and John Funderberg. Trustee Kline was absent. The agenda was approved as presented. Trustee Funderberg made a motion to approve the minutes for the August 12, 2025 meeting, seconded by Trustee Klinefelter. All ayes.

Payment of Bills: Trustee Funderberg made a motion to approve payment of bills totaling \$49,549.69. Seconded by Trustee Kunkel. All ayes on a roll call vote. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report: Trustee Funderberg made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as presented by Ginger Murphy, seconded by John Funderberg. All ayes. Motion Approved.

Supervisor's Report:

- Water treatment plant: No issues: No new information on Filtration Replacement. Media has been ordered.
- Wastewater Treatment Plant: No issues.
- Lift Stations: 1 alarm - 18 August - Brief Power outage.
- Parks: West Park - No issues; East Park - No issues; Numosh Park - No issues; waiting on bids for fountains.
- 111 New Meters have been installed
- Vehicles: No issues.

Public Comment:

Jerry and Helen Murphy were present to address the overflowing cat problem on and around their corner of Jefferson and Brewster Streets. Their property has been overrun by cats and the problems associated with the overpopulation. Linda Joiner also registered a complaint about the cat issues. and Hopper were present to talk about the issue. No solution was mentioned.

Village Engineer:

Jack Kusek stated that the following week the State Street Bridge would be worked on. And work on the others will follow.;

Mr. Kusek completed bridge inspections on Walnut Street Bridge, State Street Bridge, Arch Street Bridge and Galena Street Bridge. Galena Street Bridge needs painting underneath below the deck. Estimated cost \$10,000.00. He will seek out a contractor.

Water Tower: The water tower painting design was agreed upon, and will be sent to the designer.

Sand Filter Media has been ordered.

It was decided to have a set of nozzles on hand, for the sand filters for back up. The water quality has stabilized for now at about 75% less brown water. The village will continue flushing, etc.

Trustee Klinefelter reported that Road Commissioner Chris Hicks has been looking at the drainage problem at the bottom of the hill leading out of town to the golf course. Still working on the problem.

The missing drainage culvert at Nancy Hubers needs to be addressed.

Trustee Cole reported that he has marked a number of holes - with white paint - that need to be filled in the parks and by the dog park.

Trustee Funderberg reported that a resident on East Main was burning landscape waste in violation of the ordinance. There are multiple issues with the same residence that need to be addressed.

Employee Dilcher needs to be reminded to drive the village vehicle while working for the village and not his personal vehicle.

It was reported that some young people had been entering the water treatment plant, when no one was present. Employees will be reminded this door needs to be locked.

Trustee Yepsen stated that it would take about 2 weeks for the street overlay to be completed. Trustee Kunkel will be monitoring the insurance needs for the Village.

Trustee Kline was going to take care for the weather radio survey, no update was given in her absence. Motion was made by Trustee Klinefelter and seconded by Trustee Yepsen to temporarily suspend the survey. All ayes, Motion Approved.

Trustee Funderberg showed the board some colored designs for the West Park game area. Need to have a specific drawing with correct colors by next meeting.

The Tuesday, September 9th meeting of the board has been cancelled.

Trustee Klinefelter made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Trustee Kunkel. All ayes. Meeting adjourned.
