The Park Commission meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chair Paul Johnson.

PUBLIC COMMENT

SOCCER FIELD USE FOR A HOME SCHOOL PROGRAM AT WALES COMMUNITY PARK

QUOTES TO REMOVE THE FENCING AT THE SOCCER FIELDS IN WALES COMMUNITY PARK

DISCUSSION: If we were to remove the fencing and replace it with parking stop, we would need 330 and they would have to be removed in the fall for snow plowing and reinstalled in the spring. These would also have to be stored over the winter. The quote for 330 is \$21,000. If we were to go with parking delineators, the cost would be \$13,071.16 for 330 and we would also have to install in the spring and remove in the fall and store them for the season. Quotes for the removal and replacement of the fence, range from \$9,875 - \$86,325.55 depending on what would be used to replace the current fence. It was asked that Theresa get more quotes to replace the fence with large stones around the perimeter of the parking lot.

MOTION: No motion at this time, item tabled for the June Park Commission meeting.

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JOBS FOR BUILDING AND GROUNDS

DISCUSSION: The new bleachers for Wales Community Park have been delivered and will be installed next week. Water has been turned on at the park and the restrooms have been opened. The port-a-johns have been removed from WCP and delivered to Fireman's and Breconshire Parks. 2 Blue bird houses were installed at Breconshire Park and maybe we should not consider installing a butterfly garden there as they could be eaten by the blue birds. The diamonds at Fireman's need to be sprayed this season for weeds. There are 2 seasonal employees are working with two more to begin by the end of May. They have been cutting grass twice a week with all the rain. The brush pickup went very well and Theresa should look into having one in the fall.
