

PARK COMMISSION JULY 8, 2024

The Park Commission meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chair Paul Johnson.

Members present: Paul Johnson, Alan Barrows, Mary Ziebell, Tammy Johnson, and Gil Ziebell.

Also Present: Deputy Clerk Pauline Wigderson, Maintenance Supervisor Theresa Sadler, and Nate Day of SEH.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No public comment.

Park Commission acknowledged receipt of the minutes for the Park Commission meeting of June 10, 2024, motion by Tammy Johnson to approve the minutes and waive the requirement of reading same, second by Mary Ziebell, motion passed unopposed.

COMPREHENSIVE PARK PLAN

DISCUSSION: Nate Day of SEH created the survey and was sent to Park Commission members to review. A few changes need to be made – change cross country skiing to snow shoe trail; change volleyball to beach volleyball as we would put sand under the nets and not a hard surface; change sports field to dome/indoor sport field; add an open air farmers market on the Glacial Drumlin Trail and ask if they would be interested in joining a “Friends of Wales Parks” with the Deputy Clerk’s email address to respond to for that question. Nate will make the changes and send the survey to the Deputy Clerk to send out on the email list, the Village’s facebook page, and post on the Village’s website. Nate will also send a “QR Code” that can be posted in the parks and various areas throughout the Village. While anyone can respond to the survey, we have added – “What is the name of the Street that you live on” so we can see the responses residents vs non-residents. The link will stay open until September 2, 2024. Pauline will send out the 1993 Comprehensive Park Plan so they can review the goals and objectives and work on new ones for the new comprehensive plan at the next Park Commission meeting.

MOTION: No motion at this time.

JOBS FOR BUILDING AND GROUNDS

DISCUSSION: They have been working on trimming the trees on the roadsides and in the parks. The fencing has been removed at the soccer fields and the stones have been placed as a barrier. Their next project is to get the storage and concession buildings in order. The lawn mowing is still going strong with all the rain. A skag will need to have some maintenance done. The summer team is working well.

The next Park Commission meeting will be on August 20, 2024, starting at 5:00 p.m. at Breconshire Park.
