Quotes are being requested for a gate at Wales Community Park because of the vandalism on the soccer fields. They have looked at the gate at Lapham Peak and will look at the gate at Sunset Park in Genesee. They would like to have an automatic gate so that no one would have to come out to open and close the gate each day. A plan is being worked on to eliminate the weeds by the sledding hill. They have cut them, but they keep coming back. Robert would like to work on adding more signage in the parks regarding recycling.
