June 16, 2022

Call Meeting to Order: Chair Doering called the meeting to order at 4:00 P.M.

Committee Members Present: Finance*Personnel*Insurance Committee Members: Chairperson Robert (Al) Doering, Trustee Michael Carignan, Trustee Mike Weiland all present.

Others Present: Clerk/Treasurer Nicki Breunig, Director of Public Works Brad Corrao, and Hayden Breunig present in person.

Adopt Agenda as Presented: Motion to adopt Carignan/Weiland. Motion carried 3-0.

NEW BUSINESS

1. **Discussion/Review – Village of North Freedom Part Time Mower Help:**

There are so far 2 persons interested in help mowing, Michael Romero & Hayden Breunig, just from initial talks. Michael would be available Wednesday/Thursday and Hayden would be available nights/weekends. Current part-time workers are paid \$16.00/hour. Mowing could be completed in 15 hours. Multiple locations to mow in the Village. DPW is content with how things are at the moment and able to complete during regular hours. Up to Board. Position would be at the discretion of the DPW to call in the person to work. The position could possibly help with other misc. DPW jobs. C/T brought up numbers. DPWs mowing for Village property (other than Water/Sewer locations) are paid out of Parks/Rec. Village budgeted \$15,000.00 for Parks/Rec expenses for 2022. Village has currently paid \$15,315.09 out of Parks/Rec but \$11,291.00 was for the LED sign that was paid for out of a transfer from the Parks Sinking Fund. $15,315.09 - 11,291.00 = 4,024.09$ already expensed for 2022. That remains \$10,975.91 to still be expensed out of Parks/Rec expenses. Example: If someone was hired after the Village Board meeting in July (July 11) to mid-September that would be 9 weeks. $9 \text{ weeks} \times 16.00/\text{hour} \times 15 \text{ hours/week} = \2160.00 potentially coming out of Parks/Rec. Leaving \$8,815.91 approximately to still be expensed out. Committee would like to propose to full Board hiring a part-time DPW worker for a maximum of 15 hours a week at \$16.00/hour to help with primarily mowing and potentially any other DPW jobs. Chair Doering would like to see it posted on the Village website/social media to see if there are others interested. C/T will post.
