1. Call to Order

- Lisa called the meeting to order at 8:03 pm

2. Approval of Minutes from last Meeting

The minutes from the February 2026 meeting were reviewed and approved as presented.

3. Treasurer's Report

- Current account balance: \$74,162.86
- Loan payment for the splashpad was made \$11,958 end of February 2026.

Jamie made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, Brian 2nd, the motion carried, and was approved.

Old Business

4. Bids for concrete at Splashpad, phase 2

- Still waiting on Bids- everyone is backed up. Jamie is hoping to hear soon- Lisa will reach out to Knife River to give them an update since they are donating the concrete.
- Lisa is contacting Bob Ell with the Wilton Legion to see how they want their name on the splash pad sign. A small sign will be added below the existing sign.

New Business

5. Bids for fixing the wire above ground at East Field (South Park)

- Shipley and Western Edge- Both within a couple of hundred dollars of each other- Western Edge was at the park looking at the project and stated the cost would be less than his bid, now that he saw what needed to be done.
- Western Edge will also be fixing the wireless module in the new scoreboard on the west field
- All of the wire work is expected to be completed by the 1st week in May, as it needs to be completed for an upcoming softball Jamboree. This was discussed with Western Edge, and he stated the work could be completed by the deadline.

Nicole made a motion to accept Western Edge's bid and for him to begin the work. Amy, 2nd, the motion carried and was approved.

6. Summer Help/Salaries

- Positions for coaching, mowing, and coordinator have been filled. Lisa will let the city know.
- Coordinator position- \$2500 (summer season), Coaching positions- \$18.50/hour, Mowers- \$16.00/hour

Nicole made a motion to approve summer salaries, Amy 2nd, the motion passed and was approved.

- Summer Softball is getting a bid for jerseys instead of t-shirts- They will use the money they earned on concessions last year to help pay for jerseys and asked that the park board pay the overage cost.

Amy made a motion for the park board to cover any overage in purchasing jerseys for summer softball, Brian 2nd, the motion passed, and was approved.

7. South Park Shelter

- The shelter is reserved for a graduation on Sunday, May 24th, 2-6 pm
- July 13th- Lions annual meeting 6 pm
- July 18th, Lions are hosting an event (all day)
- July 26-27th, Bike race- using the park's facilities

8. Softball Regionals

- New pitching mound (dirt moved to level it)
- The main field home plate needs to be straightened
- Seeding and marking sprinklers
- Jamie is calling the city to schedule the water to be turned on, and Brian is going through buildings to ensure all water is off prior.
- Amy, Lisa, and Nicole will repaint the dugouts before Regionals.
- Water meter being installed in the next couple of weeks.
