(b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations. This shall not be an evidentiary session. No village employees will be in attendance.
6. **Further** to adjourn into closed session under Sec. 19.85(1)(e) for: Deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session in order to discuss the wholesale power contract with Wisconsin Power and Light.
7. **Further** to consult with the Village Attorney under 19.85 (1) (g) Conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved. All with respect to actions taken by the Wonewoc Electrical Utility
8. Close out of the Closed session
9. Consider any motions concerning the three closed session items.
